



Mayor's Award for Architectural Design and Restoration

An important part of the revitalization of any downtown is the improvement and restoration of existing buildings, and the construction of architecturally compatible new buildings. To recognize the aesthetic improvements that building owners and developers have made to the downtown, the city is initiating an annual award program for outstanding design and restoration of residential and commercial buildings in greater downtown Caldwell. Greater downtown Caldwell is defined as east to Indiana, south to Linden, west to Paynter, and north to Interstate 84.

The Site Review Team will accept and review applications that demonstrate designs, remodels or restorations that are compatible to the architectural style of the downtown or original historic styles of design theme.

Categories include:

- New Construction: Residential or Commercial/Non-profit
- Restoration/Renovation: Residential or Commercial/Non-profit

The application process will begin in January of each year, with nominations due by March 31st. Anyone can nominate a building or project for consideration for those architectural projects that are completed by March 31st. A selection committee will choose winners from each category and those winners will be announced in June.
